Grant-Making Guidelines

Community non-profit and service organizations are eligible to apply for grants through the Willow Lake Area Community Foundation. We prefer to support organizations that have 501c3 non-profit status with the IRS. However, if your organization does not have 501c3 status, please do apply; we still may be able to support your community project. Projects must benefit the people in one or all of our local communities: Willow Lake, Vienna, and/or Carpenter. Our grants may not be used to fund general operating expenses, trips, camps, or memberships. Our grants are meant to support projects that enhance life for local residents and visitors, and improve our communities for the better.
